Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

between

Government College of Education, Aurangabad.

and

Marathwada College of Education, Aurangabad

This MoU is made between

Govt. College of Education, I.A.S.E., Aurangabad is the oldest and reputed teacher's training (NAAC 'A' Grade Re-accredited in 2015 with CGPA- 3.27) institution which was established in 1954 prior to the establishment of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad (initially Affiliated to Osmania University, Hyderabad) by Ministry of Higher & Technical Education Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai for catering to the needs of pre-service and in-service teachers.

This Institute is now upgraded as **An Institute for Advanced Studies in Education (I.A.S.E.)** by **Ministry of Human Resource Development, New Delhi** under the centrally sponsored scheme for expansion of Teacher's Training in Maharashtra under the **NEP 1986**.

The Marathwada College of Education, (MCE), Aurangabad established by the founder President of MAES (Late) Dr. Rafiq Zakaria, having its Headquarters in Mumbai, Maharashtra State, India and office at Dr. Rafiq Zakaria Campus, Rauza Bagh, Aurangabad, Maharashtra State, India. The college was accorded College of Teacher Education in the year 2007 under IASE, Govt. College of Education, Aurangabad. In order to collaborate and engage in academic and research activities, and to make educational exchanges for mutual benefits, Govt. College of Education, Aurangabad and the Marathwada College of Education, Aurangabad agree to formalize Memorandum of Understanding for :

Academic Collaboration under the following areas –

- a) Teacher Training (College and School Teachers)
- b) Joint Seminar/Conference/Workshop
- c) Faculty Exchange

1. Rationale of Collaboration :

Marathwada College of Education, Aurangabad is the very first college in Marathwada Region of Maharashtra which was established with a view to impart training to teachers of Urdu Medium Schools in particular, in addition to teachers of English Medium and Marathi Medium schools. Being a premier institution with a track record of excellent results and thorough teacher training programs, the college with its collaboration with the oldest Teacher Training Institution, will provide an opportunity to conduct Academic activities relating to various factors that are involved and that affect the growth of schools teachers and college teachers in Maharashtra State in particular and across India in general. This collaboration between Marathwada College of Education and Govt. College of Education, Aurangabad will also help to conduct Joint Teachers Training Programs in order to facilitate the enhancement of the quality training and enhancing competence of the teachers of schools and colleges which is vision of both the colleges.

2. Type of Collaboration/Cooperation/Partnership :

- a. Govt. College of Education, Aurangabad and Marathwada College of Education will jointly conduct training programmes in various areas such as teaching learning practices in Secondary Schools. The areas may also include the role of Marathwada College of Education and Govt. College of Education, Aurangabad in 'Capacity Building of Teachers for the 21st Century' in order to enhance Quality Education with ample scope for both students' and teachers' progress. Marathwada College of Education will also do the impact analysis to provide recommendations for the quality education of undergraduate students with a view to improve their socio economic status. Marathwada College of Education will furnish the required information and data and also details of the scope of counseling in the area of Education.
- b. Govt. College of Education, Aurangabad and MCE will jointly conduct Teachers Training Programme for inservice teachers of schools and colleges and facilitate faculty exchange programme. MCE will identify the schools to depute the teachers to attend such training programs in Aurangabad, likewise Govt. College of Education, Aurangabad will also simultaneously identify teachers from Marathi Medium Schools of Aurangabad.

- c. Govt. College of Education, Aurangabad and MCE propose to jointly organized Seminar/Workshop/Conferences/Awareness Programmes at the National level.
- d. Govt. College of Education, Aurangabad and MCE propose come forward for joint publication of journals at both offline and online levels.

3. **Financial Implications and Risks :**

The cost of all the academic collaborative ventures undertaken will be jointly shared by both Govt. College of Education, Aurangabad and Marathwada College of Education in accordance with the revenue generated and as mutually agreed upon by both.

Implementation of Govt. College of Education, Aurangabad :

- a. Any of the information exchanged between Marathwada College of Education and Govt. College of Education, Aurangabad under this MoU will be treated as confidential and shall not be disclosed to any third party either in Aurangabad or Maharashtra unless it is agreed between the two parties. Nothing in this MoU shall however be deemed to prohibit disclosure of any confidential information required under the law/court order, or by any regulatory or Governmental Authority.
- b. This MoU may, by mutual consent in writing may be altered, amended or substituted from time to time during the terms of this agreement at the hands of duly authorized representative of the parties.
- c. No failure or omission by either party to carry out or observe any terms or conditions shall give rise for any claim against the other party or be deemed as a breach of this agreement if such failure or omission arises from any cause reasonably beyond the control of the party.
- d. MCE and Govt. College of Education, Aurangabad has caused this MoU to be executed as of the day and year first written above.

4. **Duration of MoU :**

The MoU will come into force on the date of sign in by the parties and will remain in force for a period of three years.


5. **Extension/Revision/Termination of MoU :**






